

Pre K and K On Grounds Pre- and Post Visit Activities

Pre-visit Activities: On Grounds Program

1. Explore creature colors, using books and pictures and the Wild Animal Park's website. Ask the students what colors do they see on the animals? Which animals have more colors, ones with fur, ones with feathers, or ones with scales? (Feathers or scales (fish))
2. Safari sounds – have students think of animals they might see during their visit to the Wild Animal Park and try to make their sounds. Some examples are elephants, lions, tigers, zebras (horses), ankole cattle (cows), parrots, warthogs (pigs), bat-eared foxes (dogs), or other animals discovered during activity number 1
3. Animal alphabet – Name an animal whose name starts with each letter of the alphabet

Post-visit Activity: On Grounds Program

1. Students can draw or create their own amazing animals using what they have learned paired with their imaginations. (assessment activity)
